It is the policy of the Bradford County Manor to admit and to treat all patients without regard to age, race, national origin, sex, ancestry, religious creed or handicap. There is no distinction in eligibility for, or in the manner of providing, any patient service provided by or through the nursing home. All facilities of the nursing home are available without distinction to all patients and visitors, regardless of age, race color, national origin, sex, ancestry, religious creed, or handicap. All persons and organizations that have occasion either to refer patients for admission or recommend the Bradford County Manor are advised to do so without regard to the affirmative action will be taken to employ and advance in employment qualified handicapped individuals who, with reasonable accommodation, can perform the functions of a job.
